KMA's Summer Art Academy classes are designed with age appropriate art projects that encourage your child's experimentation with a variety of art materials. Each week offers a different art class that will nourish children's creativity, challenge their skills, and improve their techniques.

Classes are held at the Knoxville Museum of Art in the Great Hall and the Sarah Jane Hardrath Kramer Education Center (1050 World's Fair Drive) and will include drawing, painting, sculpture, and more. Morning classes are offered each week for children ages 3-12 years old. Afternoon classes are offered for ages 13 and up. Classes will start Monday, June 7, and continue each week through July 30.

Tuition for the half-day workshop, \$85.00 for members and \$100.00 for nonmembers (unless specified otherwise), includes workshop supplies, instruction, and guided tours. ### Four Seasons
